If the price is not considered reasonable, CSMCL may not accept such Proposal and go for another tender process.

How will CSMCL determine too low or too high prices received in the bid?

Will be determined by CSMCL on case to case basis for each zone on whether the rate quoted for work is reasonably possible, feasible and justified or not.
